The thirteen especially composed essays that follow, organised into four sections headed ‘Paradoxes of Fidelity’, ‘Authors, Auteurs, Adaptation’, ‘Contexts, Intertexts, Adaptation’ and ‘Beyond Adaptation’, variously illustrate that claim by problematising the notion of fidelity, highlighting the role played by adaptation in relation to changing concepts of authorship and auteurism, exploring the extent to which the intelligibility of film adaptations is dependent on contextual and intertextual factors, and making a claim for the need to transcend any narrowly-defined concept of adaptation in the study of adaptation. Discussion ranges from adaptations of established classics like *A Tale of Two Cities*, *Frankenstein*, *Henry V*, *Le temps retrouvé*, *Mansfield Park*, *Pride and Prejudice*, ‘The Dead’ or *Wuthering Heights*, to contemporary (popular) texts/films like *Bridget Jones’s Diary*, *Fools*, *The Governess*, *High Fidelity*, *The Hours*, *The Orchid Thief*/Adaptation, the work of Doris Dörrie, the first *Harry Potter* novel/film, or the adaptations made by Alfred Hitchcock, Stanley Kubrick and Walt Disney. This book will appeal to both a specialised readership and to those accessing the dynamic field of adaptation studies for the first time.
